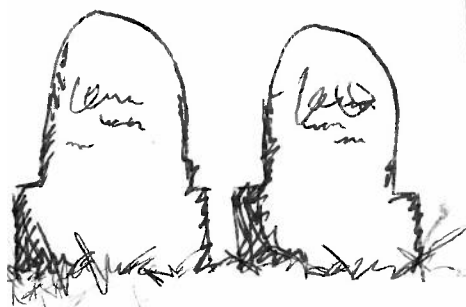

 sciences and arts.

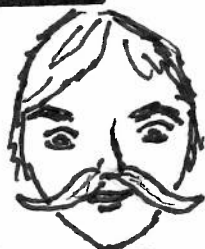
Other noble women

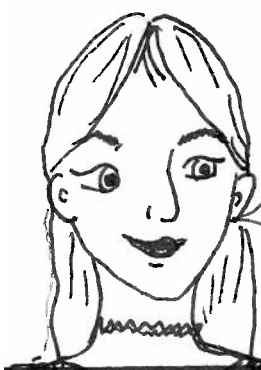
Doña Juana (dressed as Doctor Madrid) and Doctor Bermudez hear the commotion and rush over.

the students enter Serafina's house

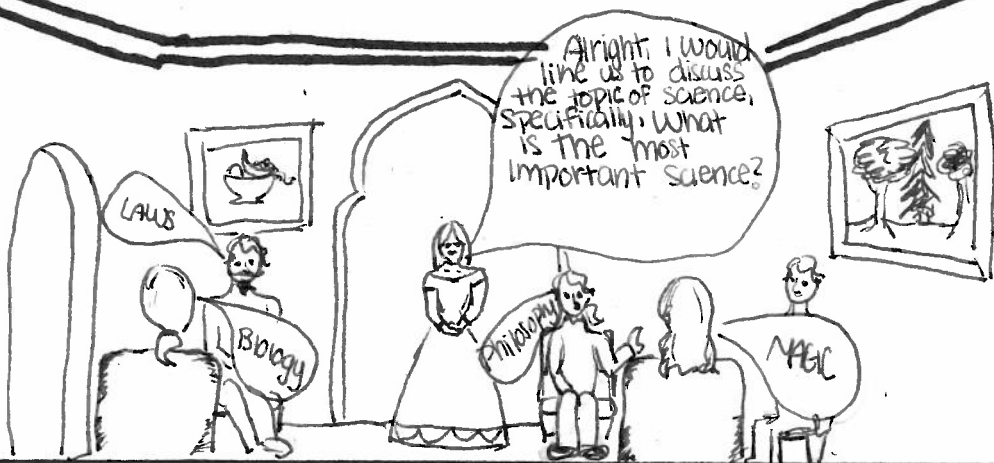


Bienvenidos todos!

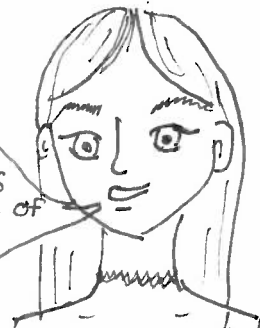
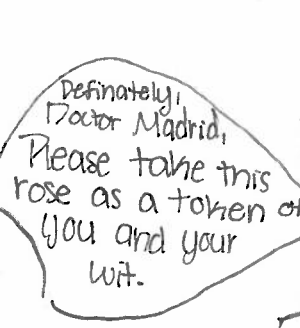

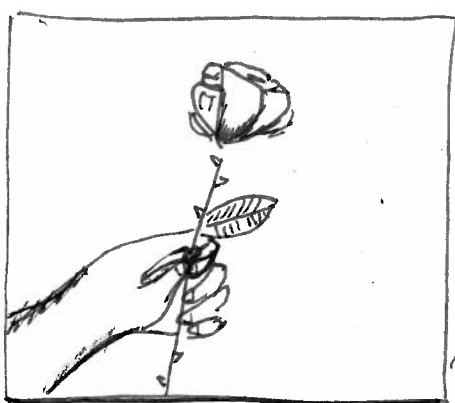
**Fileno:** Magic is a power far more powerful than Biology.
